Dear Chair Fine:

I have observed that as of noon today, the 6-10 West 70<sup>th</sup> Street matter is still on the web site agenda for the Land Use Committee for June 20, 2007. The matter was only placed on the agenda on June 10, which itself was questionable.

The letter of June 15, 2007 from the BSA in substance states that the Congregation's BSA application is not complete, and, in fact is so incomplete, that unless the Congregation revises its application, BSA will dismiss the application.

The BSA cover letter states:

The Board desires to process applications on a timely basis and requests that applicants notify the Board if they are unable to make a <u>complete</u> submission within sixty (60) days.

Accordingly, a meeting of the Land Use Committee is premature, because the BSA has stated that the application is not complete. The Land Use Committee has no jurisdiction to consider this matter, and, it is as well completely inappropriate for meetings like this to be held when so much is wrong and missing in the application.

It is not even appropriate to have a status meeting – basically, BSA bounced the application and has told the Congregation that if it is not fixed witching 60 days, the application will be bounced. Please do not waste the time of the community by entertaining the matter at this time. But, if the Committee does proceed on Wednesday night, we will have a court stenographer there to take a record.
